VA stands up commission to recommend new Veterans Health Administration Under Secretary

WASHINGTON — The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) established a commission to identify candidates to lead and manage the Veterans Health Administration (VHA). The position is for the Under Secretary for Health, who oversees the country's largest health care system — which has an approximate annual budget of \$61 billion — and supervises the delivery of care to more than 9 million enrolled Veterans.

By law, the appointment is made without regard to political affiliation and solely on demonstrated ability in the medical profession, policy formulation, and health care administration and fiscal management. Those being considered must have substantial experience in connection with the programs of VHA or programs of similar content and scope.

Duties of the post include overseeing the operation of VA's more than 1,200 sites of care, including hospitals, community-based outpatient clinics, nursing homes, domiciles and 300 Vet Centers. The candidates should have a demonstrated ability to conceptualize and implement a vision, while being an advocate who can move an ambitious agenda forward to meet the needs of Veterans.

VHA is the nation's largest provider of graduate medical education and a major contributor to medical and scientific research. More than 73,000 active volunteers, 123,000 health professions trainees, and 306,000 full-time, health-care professionals and support staff are an integral part of the VHA community.

COVID-19 pandemic.

VA allocates \$1B to aid State Veterans Homes amid COVID-19 pandemic

WASHINGTON — The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) announced it will make grants totaling \$1 billion to <u>State Veterans Homes</u> operated across the country to ensure residents continue to receive high quality care, live in modern, safe facilities and are protected from the

VA is appreciative to Congress for providing the funding for these grants in the <u>American Rescue Plan</u> (ARP) Act of 2021 and the <u>Coronavirus Aid</u>, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES) Act as amended by the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021.

"Too many Veterans residing in State Veterans Homes have suffered greatly during this challenging pandemic and it's vital that we do everything within our power to help them through these tough times," said VA Secretary Denis McDonough. "We are working to ensure our Veterans are protected and that their state-run homes are well equipped for the challenges ahead."

Source and allocation of funds:

- \$500 million from ARP designated to provide grants through the current capital grant program for construction of State Veterans homes.
- \$250 million from ARP designated for grants related to operating needs based on each state's share of total Veteran residents in nursing home and domiciliary care.
- \$150 million from CARES Act designated for grants for capital needs for construction funds to modify buildings to prepare, prevent or respond in order to mitigate the risk of COVID-19.

\$100 million designated by the <u>Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021</u>, for grants for emergency payments to existing State Veterans Homes to prevent, prepare and respond to COVID-19.



VA, American Red Cross team up to provide virtual social engagement for Veterans during COVID-19 pandemic

WASHINGTON — The Department of Veterans
Affairs (VA) and American Red Cross announced a
partnership to boost volunteer recruitment efforts
for the department's Compassionate Contact

Corps program, which provides companionship to Veterans experiencing social isolation during the

COVID-19 pandemic.

The program allows physicians, chaplains, nurses and social workers to pair volunteers with Veterans

who are experiencing loneliness, are at risk for social isolation or could benefit from a companion.

"Since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic, VA has worked diligently to find viable ways to engage

Veterans who are staying home per guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention," said

VA Center for Development and Civic Engagement Director Sabrina Clark. "Compassionate Contact

Corps was born out of a desire to help our Veterans who are at home to constructively engage with

others while keeping them and our volunteers safe."

"We regard VA's Compassionate Contact Corps as a best practice and signature program," said American

Red Cross Senior Vice President Koby Langley. "It directly aligns with our organization's mission and the

expertise of its cadres across a vast nationwide network of volunteers to prevent and alleviate human

suffering whenever possible."

Veterans and volunteers are matched based on common interests, with volunteers making regular

phone or video calls to Veterans.

Volunteers must be 18 years of age or older, successfully pass a background check and complete training

on confidentiality, privacy, customer service, empathy, compassion, active listening and boundaries.

Volunteers do not have to be Veterans or clinicians.

Veterans interested in participating require a referral by a VA clinician. Interested volunteers can find

available opportunities at their local VA or at the American Red Cross.

I want to start off my letter to you, by thanking all of you for your hard work over the last year. We lived through difficult times, and accomplished so much together ... in our Assemblies, in our communities, and District wide in the State of New Hampshire.

Membership Growth: During the course of the 2020-2021 fraternal year, you continued your push to recruit and propose new members to the patriotic 4th Degree. The District of New Hampshire was given a goal of 138 new members. Our June Degree held at the Cathedral of St.

Joseph, was thought to be our final Degree, however, Secretary, Ed McCann and I proposed ... one more Online Exemplification, to make the final push for membership. Multiple Assemblies canvased Council member rosters and exemplified over two dozen more members, ending the year with 147 total member income at 106%. Now that we're in a new fraternal year ... we're already looking ahead to our next Degree as well as greater opportunities with membership with our College Councils, Veterans Council and membership for our Priests within the Diocese of Manchester.

Assembly Growth: In continuity with Supreme and in expanding our patriotic outreach within our communities, we've taken a more focused approach in opening new Assemblies in areas where our Priests are wanting a more Parish based contact and concentration in patriotic programming. In nearing the end of the month of June, we finalized the incorporation of "St. John Vianney Assembly #3893", with SK, Allen Ouellette becoming the Assemblies founding Faithful Navigator. This Assembly in Newport, will provide a more Parish based support for St. Patrick Parish in Newport, as well as focused patriotic programming for the community, as well as the outreach that their Faithful Friar, Fr. Michael Sartori, looks for. Faithful Navigator, Ouellette and his Assembly Sir Knights have hit the ground running in communicating with and proposing members, as well as working on exciting programming initiatives with Fr. Sartori. GREAT THINGS are awaiting Assembly #3893.

Multi-media Outreach: Our District has continued its multi-media outreach with our Facebook page, creating a greater ease of access to the membership, in sharing the latest of what we have been accomplishing, on a moment's notice. That, coupled with our "Patriotic Review" newsletter, has enhanced our ability to communicate with our Brother Sir Knights.

On the horizon: There are so many updates to provide on what's on the horizon, that I'd ask you to share this newsletter with your Brother Sir Knights, so that they can keep up on the page by page action. Our membership campaigns and raffles are continuing. Our VAVS Chairman, David DeWorken, DW and his wife will be picking back up on their communication with various Veteran's Agencies, and creating greater friendships and relationship. Expect exciting initiatives from Dave. We'll be scheduling a "Mid-Year" meeting, a "Biennial" meeting and abilities for Assemblies in Color Corps training. So much to do throughout our communities and to participate throughout the District ... stay healthy and stay strong!

Dear Brother Knight:

Your immediate action is necessary to protect taxpayer funding from being used to pay for abortion.

FORM 4 "FILLABLE" APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

My Brother Knights and Sir Knights:

We have come a long way over these few months and reached our district goal for membership but not without the help from each of you. With the help of the new electronic Form 4 that is 100% fillable we have been able to move documentation along in an extremely fast fashion.

Our District Master indicates that a Faithful Navigator has the power to accept an application, add his name electronically to the Form and forward to me for processing. Supreme is loving this form because they can read all info without questioning signatures and other info that has not been clearly filled out.

With this said, I am asking **ALL future Form 4's** be electronically filled out and forwarded to me when completed. My assistance is always available. Two areas that seem to be missed on many of the forms I received in the past is that the Membership Number and Email addresses are missing. If you do not know where to enter this info, first look in the upper right corner of the form. This is where that Membership Number should go. As far as the email address, this is located in the blank area just above the name of the candidate. First Degree dates can be acquired from the FS of your council by looking at the Council Roster.

Here are the instructions to follow. Please reference these or call me with your questions.

- 1. Download the file.
- 2. Save file from your Download folder
- 3. Always make a copy of this file for your use.
- 4. Rename your copy -- Example (McCann App.pdf)
- 5. Open file with Acrobat
- 6. Move to area that needs to be edited and type in information
- 7. Save file and send to FS for his electronic signing. (Remember Membership # and Email Address)
- 8. FS then sends to the Assembly's FC for approval with a check from Applicant.
- 9. Assembly FN and FC should type in information, Proposer name, Assembly number and Membership Number and forward to me for processing. Format for Dates 6/23/21 do not use (-) or (.)
- 10. This process of filling out everything electronically is acceptable by our State Master, Glenn Camley, PSD and Supreme
- 11. Save a copy for your records. (All signatures can be done electronically)
- 12. Send Completed forms and checks to me for processing.


