## Resolution 2022-09

### RESOLUTION TO CHANGE THE STATE KIDNEY BY-LAWS

**Whereas** the New Hampshire State Council of the Knights of Columbus has supported persons needing assistance with non-covered and co-pay costs associated with dialysis;

**Whereas** the New Hampshire State Council has noticed a decided down turn in request for assistance;

**Whereas** the authorization for the State Council to solicit funds, manage the funds and distribute funds has expired and;

**Whereas** the need for assistance of those seeking assistance with kidney transplant and kidney disease recovery is great;

**Therefore, be it resolved that** the following rules are proposed as a standing Resolution set to expire in 5-years and requiring a re-examination of the process for improvements at that time;

1. The Kidney Fund be administered by the Executive Board of the NH State Council with nonvoting advisors of the State Kidney Chairman and two District Deputies appointed by the State Deputy.
2. The Kidney Fund be reviewed each year at the January Executive Board meeting for proposed improvement changes which will be submitted as Resolutions for the State Council Delegates to vote on at the State Convention.
3. The level of financial support be set by the Executive Board each year based on the financial condition of the Kidney Fund, the number of patients currently being supported, the average and maximum yearly expenditures for all Program Patients and recommendations of the NH State Council Kidney Chairman and the State Secretary.
4. Exception funding of patients in financial need past the currently set quarterly limit, be reviewed and approved by the Executive Committee based of sound financial decision making with regards to the health of the Kidney Fund and on the basis of charity.
5. The State Secretary be responsible for composing standard operating practices for the operation of the State Kidney Fund and they be approved by the Executive Board of the NH State Council. Revisions to all operating practices will be submitted as needed by the current serving State Secretary to the Executive Board for review and approval. These operating practices be published electronically and made available to all State Council Delegates.
6. The Kidney Fund coverage of kidney prescriptions be expanded to those patients who have received kidney transplants and are in financial need.

**Be it further resolved that** the New Hampshire State Council of the Knights of Columbus create a continuing program call The Kidney Fund to continue providing assistance to dialysis persons in need and in conjunction with any entity wishing to help provide nephrology transplant services to the needed and distressed. Such Program to be reviewed every 5 years by the Executive Committee and a recommendation for continuance or discontinuance be then made to the Membership of the State Council;

**Be it further resolved that** this Resolution authorized the Executive Committee to enter into agreement with entities providing medical nephrology services to raise funds and assist in the distribution of those funds to those in most need throughout the jurisdiction and its environs and that the State Secretary create a set of general rules for this program to be implemented by the Kidney Fund Director.

**Whereas** Bishop Matthew Brady was named the fifth Bishop of Manchester, New Hampshire, by Pope Pius XII on November 11, 1944;

**Whereas** he presided over a period of unprecedented growth in the Manchester Diocese, founding 27 parishes in 11 years and authorizing the construction of nearly 50 churches and numerous schools, convents, and other facilities;

**Whereas** he also increased the number of Catholics by 50,000, and the number of priests and religious from around 650 to over 1,600;

**Whereas** for all these accomplishments he was nicknamed "Brady the Builder";

**Whereas** the Knights of Columbus New Hampshire State Council solicits scholarship applications in memorial of Bishop Matthew Brady from eligible applicants as defined by applicable current state council resolutions, including information relating to the academic potential and the financial need of the applicants;

**Whereas** the Knights of Columbus New Hampshire State Council annually awards four (4) such scholarships in the amount of \$750.00 each as determined by the executive board of the state council and;

**Whereas** the Knights of Columbus State Council values its commitment to religious vocations by actively support vocations to the priesthood and religious life through the RSVP and Penny-A-Day-A- Knight programs;

**Therefore, be it resolved that** the Knights of Columbus New Hampshire State Council shall annually award one (1) additional scholarship to an eligible seminarian, postulant, or someone in the religious vocation formation process as determined by the Director of Vocations for the Diocese of Manchester in the amount of \$1,250.00.

**Be it further resolved that** All Registrations shall be obtained from the NH Department of Motor Vehicles or their designees not to include the decal.

**Be it further resolved that** No decal shall be issued to anyone who is not a Member in Good Standing of the Order

**Be it further resolved that** The cost of the decal to be charged Members shall be set by the State Council Board of Directors at any meeting of the Officers.

**Be it further resolved that** The State Advocate shall maintain a list of to whom such decals are issued as is required by law Transmission of those names to the DMV as is required by law; An accounting of the cost to manufacture (as manufacture os limited by State Law); The proceeds each quarter sale of the one-time sale of the decal.

**Be it further resolved that** The proceeds of the sale of decals shall be donated to the NH State Council Kidney Fund for distribution to either the Kidney Funds or to the jointly sponsored Nephrology Fund of Dartmouth Hitchcock Hospital.

#### Definitions:

**Decal Plates** in this regulation refers to the legally issued plates of the NH Department of Motor Vehicles capable of bearing an authorized decal [RSA261:B et seq].

**State Advocate** refers to the person elected to that office of the NH State Council, Knights of Columbus.

**Decal** refers to the decals affixed to the Decal Plate as authorized by the NH DMV.

**Be it Further Resolved**, that the Supreme Council shall create rules for the earning of this award and that similar awards be developed at the State Council level under the same qualifiers for local elected officials acting in support of the Church, life and religious freedom, and

**Be It Further Resolved**, that the Supreme Council shall create a miniature ribbon or neck device suitable for being worn in public or at fraternal events by recipients of this award having either the State (bearing a symbol of the State) or National (with an appropriate national symbol) present to designate the issuing body.
